CONNECTIONS (D – UK)

A CREATIVE PROJECT FOR OLDER PEOPLE IN MANCHESTER AND WUPPERTAL

CONNECTIONS is a creative music and dance partnership project that works with two separate groups of older people in Manchester, UK and Wuppertal, Germany. The group in Manchester have been working with a composer, Richard Taylor, and members of the orchestra to compose a new piece of music based on the theme of connections. At the same time the group in Wuppertal have been working with Choreographer Barbara Cleff on movement ideas based on the same theme. Both groups exchanged their ideas and communicated their experiences. Their new piece will be recorded by ten Manchester Camerata musicians with Music Director Gabor Takacs-Nagy, then sent to Germany for Barbara Cleff to use as the stimulus for a new piece of dance with Tanztheater fur Menschen ab 55 at the Adult Education Centre Wuppertal, Bergische Volkshochschule.
